Colossians 2:6-10 "Fullness in Christ"

## Introduction:

*If all treasure is in knowing Christ, how will I gain it? And what will it be like to possess such treasure?*

## The Path to Fullness (Verses 6-7)

- 1) How did the Colossians receive Christ?

# Questions for Families, Couples, and Friends

Colossians 2:6-10

- 1) **(Reflection on Fullness)** Think about what a truly “Full” life would be like. Talk about the different things that people claim will bring fullness. How do they measure up? Can they really bring fullness?
  
- 2) **(Continuing)** Much of the New Testament calls us to continue the faith we had at first. We are instructed over and over not to abandon or add anything to it. What makes this difficult? Why do we get side-tracked? What are some things you can do as a group of friends, or as a family, to help each other stay the course?
  
- 3) **(Deceptive Philosophies)** What is attractive about trying to get to God from creation? Why is this a fundamentally flawed place to begin the search for God, meaning, reality, etc.?
  
- 4) **(Gospel Fullness)** Fullness comes from Christ. In fact, it’s already ours. How does “being brought to fullness” impact your daily walk with God? (By the way, this verse should have MASSIVE implications for “living in Christ.”)
  
- 5) **(Fullness in Christ)** Spend some time just reflecting on everything you have in Jesus. Write it out. Talk about it. Make a poem. Create a list. Do whatever it takes to spend time just thinking about THE FULLNESS of knowing Jesus. Then, give Him praise.
