- 4) **(Putting on Christ’s Mercy)** Talk about forgiveness. What is it? How do you know when its been given? Does this mean that the sin is forgotten? Use Christ as your example in answering all of these questions.

- 5) **(Putting on Christ’s Love)** Talk about the difficulties in loving others, and how the rich love of God helps us to love other people. Spend some time sharing about the moments in life when you have most felt God’s love, then use these as fuel to go out and love others this week.
