- 1) Read the imaginary scenario on pages 165-167 (note that this book was written before the global COVID pandemic).
 - a. How prepared was West Side for COVID?
 - b. How would we have fared without "online church"?
 - c. What must take place for West Side to be ready for a similar shut down with extremely limited or zero access to pastors?
- 2) If you could reimagine a Sunday morning service where we also emphasized disciple-making (via speaking Spirit-backed words to one another) without decreasing our desire and emphasis on the worship of God, what might change?
